LEGAL NOTICE

The Bradford County Commissioners are soliciting bids for the purchase and installation of approximately 400 sq. yds. of carpet, 1720 sq. ft. of ceramic tile, and 3 sq. yds. of linoleum. The flooring is to be installed in an office facility in Towanda. The carpet is to be Krauss Heathertone VI 28 oz. to match existing carpet in the building. The ceramic/porcelain tile is to be Daltile to match existing in the building. The carpet and tile will be direct glue down to a concrete floor. Vendors are required to verify measurements and may do so by contacting Kim Corbett at the County Maintenance office 570-265-1719. The vendor will be responsible for all floor preparation. When the bid is awarded the vendor will be required to complete installation of the carpet within one month from being awarded the bid.

All bids shall be submitted to the Chief Clerk, Bradford County Commissioners Office, Bradford County Court House 301 Main Street, Towanda, PA 18848, by 9:30 a.m. on February 10, 2011 and will be opened at the regularly scheduled meeting at 10:00 a.m. A plain sealed envelope must be marked in the lower left corner "Bid –Carpeting Purchase and Installation, February 10, 2011 ".

Please be advised that Bradford County does not receive early morning delivery for overnight mail.

Bids must be accompanied by cash, certified check, cashier's check, Bank Good Faith Check, or other irrevocable letter of credit drawn upon a bank authorized to do business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, or by a Bond with Corporate Surety in the amount of ten percent (10).

All proposals submitted must be firm for a minimum of sixty (60) days from bid opening. No bidder may withdraw a proposal within this time. The County may require the full sixty (60) days for review and award of the proposals.

All contractors must ensure that their employees, candidates for employment and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, creed, sex, age or national origin.

The Board of Commissioners reserves the right to refuse any or all proposals, and is not necessarily obligated to accept low proposal and waives all irregularities in bidding.
