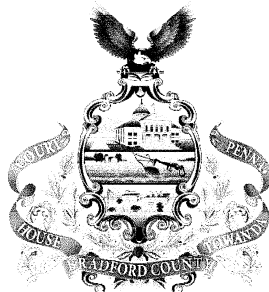

RESOLUTION 2009-02

AND NOW, this 22nd day of January, 2009, the Bradford County Commissioners, and Bradford County, a municipal corporation duly organized under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, with offices situate at 301 Main Street, Towanda, Bradford County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania)adopts the foregoing Resolution:


WHEREAS, the Bradford County Commissioners are legally responsible for the administration of the Preferential Assessment Program known as the Clean and Green Program.; and

WIHEREAS, in accordance with State Law, when a change of use occurs on a property that is not an eligible use, a rollback of taxes automatically occurs; and


WHEREAS, the past practice of the Bradford County Commissioners in the administration of the program by the Bradford County Assessment Office was to require payment within forty-five (45) days of the violation to the Bradford County Treasurer.


WHEREFORE, in order to avoid imposing a hardship for taxpayers who violate the Clean and Green Program requirements, the Commissioners will extend the payment deadline from forty-five (45) days to sixty (60) days from the notice of violation from the Bradford County Assessment Office.


