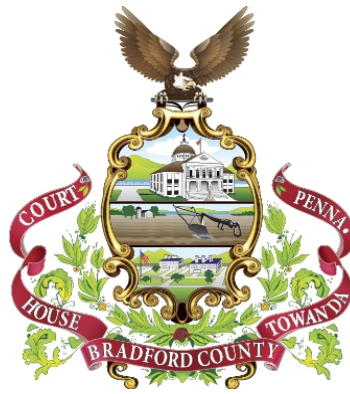

The Bradford County Energy Committee will be holding an informational session on the county's Guaranteed Energy Savings Project. The "Guaranteed Energy Savings Act" under House bill 1996 (2003) assist Commonwealth agencies with the implementation of energy saving building improvements at guaranteed no cost to the taxpayers.

The meeting will begin at 5:30 p.m. on June 17, 2010, in the Commissioners conference room at the Bradford County Courthouse. The meeting will give residents an opportunity to learn about the Guaranteed Energy process that the county is engaged in with Johnson Controls, Inc. It will include a presentation on the final details of the project and will allow the public to ask questions. The meeting is being held during the evening to give everyone the chance to participate.

This is a multimillion dollar project that will greatly improve the energy efficiency of county buildings. The Commissioners and the committee are working to bring energy efficiency to all county buildings. Therefore, the county believes that is important for the public to understand the process and the projects involved. Some examples of the proposed changes are: replacement windows at the courthouse, a partnership with Northern Tier Solid Waste for heat recovery for the Manor and Prison, lighting upgrades, and boiler replacement at the Manor.

We encourage everyone to participate in this opportunity to understand a project of this large scale.
